Preface

The goal of this exercise are to use these Indices as tools for self-improvements and bring about reforms in the policies and processes of Government agencies and bring about reforms in the policies and processes of Government agencies and financial institutions while creating a conducive ecosystem for foreign and domestic investment flow.

- Driving reforms at the National and State level by ranking of States
- Promoting cooperative and competitive federalism
- Enhancing citizen service delivery, ease of living and ease of doing business



High Level Flow






Create Reform Area



Steps to Create Reform Area and Actions:

- 1. Login with Nodal Admin Credentials
- 2. Select Reform >> Manage Reform Area and Action from left menu




- India Indices will be displayed
- Click Index link to create Reform Area

Nodal admin can create Reform Area and Action and Map with Index & Users

Create Reform Area






- Reform Area screen displays existing Reform Areas
- Click **Create Reform Area button to create Reform Area
- Click Reform Area Link to create Reform Action

Add Reform Area






- Enter Reform Area and Description


Click Reform Area Link to create Reform Action

Add Reform Action





- Enter reform action name & Description
- Enter target completion date in mm/dd/yyyy format
- Select priority
- Select Applicability and click to save action

Note:

The priority of the reform actions will be as following 'High' having weight 4, 'Medium' having weight 2,
'Low' having weight 1 and if 'Not feasible' will have
weightage 0. If the reform action is complete, the
Reform Action score will be considered as 3, in case
of 'in-progress' it will be 1, in case of 'yet to be
initiated' it will be 0. Along with that weightage will be
assigned as per priority.



Steps to Create Reform Area and Actions:

- 1. Login with Nodal Admin Credentials
- 2. Select Reform >> Mapping Reform Action to Index Hierarchy from left menu





Reform Mapping-Map with Index Hierarchy



Reform Action can be mapped to any abstraction level of the Index to which the Reform Area /Reform Action belongs to.

For example themes, parameter, sub-parameter, sub-sub-parameter etc. If a Reform Action is linked to an abstraction level, it will automatically be linked to the parent of that abstraction level. This linkage will reflect in Visualization.



- Select node (Themes, Parameter, Subparameter) to be mapped with the Reform Action from dropdown.
- Multiple selection of themes, parameters, sub parameters under the Index will be possible from the list
- Click to save record.

Note: Themes or Parameter or Sub-parameter), all the themes, parameters, sub-parameters based on the selection type will appear in list (only under a given Index because Reform Area and Reform Action is always tied to one Index.


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Reform Mapping – Map with Users



Steps to Create Reform Area and Actions:

- 1. Login with Nodal Admin Credentials
- 2. Select Reform >> Mapping Reform Action to Ministry User from left menu

Reform Mapping – Map with Ministry User



Nodal Admin will map the reform action by selecting Index and reform area to either Nodal Data Entry or will map to Line Admin or State Admin. Line Admin or State Admin will further map the same reform action to their respective data entry users.


Action Progress Data Entry

Steps to Create Reform Area and Actions:


- 1. Login with Data Entry User Credentials
- 2. Select Progress Data Entry >> Reform Progress Data Entry from left menu




Click icon to enter data.

Action Progress Data Entry








- Click icon to Add data to reform action.



After Approval the Data/Scores are available under Visualization




Select General button on Logged-in screen. Visualization window will be displayed as shown in next slide;


Visualization page user can see the Score.
